TOUGAS SAID HE AND NELSON MONITORED OVER THE RADIO WHAT WAS TAKING PLACE BETWEEN CAPUANO AND THE SUSPECT, TOUGAS SAID AFTER A SHORT TIME THE "BUST" SIGNAL WAS GIVEN. Sqt. Blanchard said he didn't get to the intersection next to Pier One imports until the suspect vehicle sped away from the arrest team driving towards Del Taco. Sqt. Blanchard said when he got to the intersection and saw the suspect vehicle attempt to drive into the drive thru the wrong way.

Sqt. Blanchard said he saw the suspect vehicle back up and hit the gray Nissan truck. Sqt. Blanchard said when the suspect vehicle started to drive west towards his locations he heard the first gunshots. Sqt. Blanchard said he did not see who was shooting.

Sqt. Blanchard said the suspect vehicle was driving towards his position when he heard more qunfire coming from the south end of the parking lot. Sgt. Blanchard said he saw the suspect heading for Officer Romero who was standing near a black pickup truck. Sgt. Blanchard said he drove forward to cover Officer Romero who by this time had gone down.

Sgt. Blanchard said he heard the collision when the suspect vehicle collided with Deputy Laubacher. Sgt. Blanchard said he saw the suspect vehicle continue to the west end of the parking lot where he saw the patrol officer and detectives take the two suspects into custody at the west end of the parking lot.

Sgt. Blanchard told me that after the suspect vehicle collided with the gray Nissan it pulled out and started driving west through the parking lot. Sgt. Blanchard said he saw the driver leaning over into the passenger seat while driving the car.

Sgt. Blanchard said Romero was standing in the roadway in front of a parked pickup truck. Sgt. Blanchard said he didn't think he could block the suspect vehicle. Sgt. Sgt. Blanchard said after he got to Officer Romero, Officer Romero told him that he had been hit by the suspect vehicle. Sgt. Blanchard told me that he could see a tire track across the top of Romero's shoe.

LAUBACHER SAID AT THIS TIME, WHEN HE SAW THE SUSPECT'S CAR ACCELERATING WESTBOUND THROUGH THE "DEL TACO" LOT HE ATTEMPTED TO BLOCK THE SUSPECT'S CAR IN THE LOT TO PREVENT HIS ESCAPE. LAUBACHER SAID THIS IS WHEN HIS CAR AND THE SUSPECT'S CAR "T-BONED" INTO EACH OTHER. LAUBACHER SAID WHEN HE SAW THE SUSPECT'S CAR ACCELERATING WESTBOUND THROUGH THE LOT HE SAW DETECTIVE REYES AND OTHER DETECTIVES IN THE LOT. LAUBACHER SAID HE COULD STILL HEAR SHOTS BEING FIRED. LAUBACHER SAID HE THOUGHT THE SUSPECT WAS "GOING TO GET AWAY" AND THAT THE SUSPECT "NEEDED TO BE STOPPED BEFORE ANYONE ELSE GOT HURT".

LAUBACHER SAID THE SUSPECT'S CAR HIT HIS TRUCK ON THE FRONT DRIVERS SIDE. LAUBACHER SAID HE COULD NOT REMEMBER IF HE TRIED TO BROAD SIDE THE SUSPECT'S CAR WHEN HE TRIED TO BLOCK IT. LAUBACHER SAID HE JUST TRIED TO "T-BONE" HIM. LAUBACHER SAID HE WAS NOT SURE IF THE SUSPECT'S CAR WAS PASSING HIS TRUCK AT THE TIME OF THE COLLISION. LAUBACHER SAID THE SUSPECT'S CAR WAS WESTBOUND THROUGH THE PARKING LOT AND HIS TRUCK WAS GOING NORTHBOUND THROUGH THE LOT JUST PRIOR TO THE COLLISION. LAUBACHER SAID HIS TRUCK WAS TRAVELING APPROXIMATELY 5-10 MPH AT THE TIME OF THE COLLISION.

LAUBACHER SAID THE SUSPECT'S CAR HIT HIS TRUCK HARD. LAUBACHER SAID AFTER THE COLLISION HIS TRUCK'S AIRBAGS DEPLOYED AND HIS TRUCK CONTINUED TO ROLL FORWARD. LAUBACHER SAID HE WAS NOT HURT DURING THE COLLISION

On 10-22-01, 2055 hours, I interviewed Senior Deputy Macias at the scene concerning this investigation. The following is a summary of a tape-recorded interview I had with Senior Deputy Macias:

Senior Deputy Macias is assigned as a member of the Narcotics Task Force, acting as the case agent. Macias briefly indicated the task force was conducting an investigation involving four pounds of meth. The task force involved two teams, arrest/bust team led by Senior Deputy Eddie Reyes and the surveillance team that followed the suspects to the Target parking lot. Upon arriving at the parking lot, the surveillance team maneuvered and maintained outer perimeter security.

Senior Deputy Macias parked in front of the Petco Store located at the north end of the parking lot. Macias was sitting alone in an unmarked police unit listening to the (UC) undercover officer. Macias indicated the UC was wired with a wireless transmission device that Macias was capable of monitoring. Macias was unable to see the UC and the suspects' vehicle due to numerous other vehicles parked in the parking lot.

While monitoring the UC and suspects' conversation, Macias heard via his police radio that the "bust team" received its signal to approach and arrest the suspects. Shortly thereafter, he heard via his radio, "They're running. They're running." Macias immediately drove westbound through the parking lot to the Pier1 and Del Taco area. As he approached the area, he saw the suspects' vehicle traveling westbound through the parking lot. At the same time, he saw fellow officer Harry Lacbacher was injured. Macias stopped his vehicle and immediately assisted Laubacher. Macias did not hear the shots nor did he see any of the collisions.

On 10-22-01, 2030 hours, I interviewed Officer Lappin at the scene concerning this investigation. The following is a summary of a tape-recorded interview I had with Officer Lippin:

Officer Lappin is assigned to the narcotic task force. Today, Officer Lappin was assigned as a member of the surveillance team that followed the suspects to the Target parking lot located at Los Posas Road and Hwy 101. Upon arriving at the parking lot, Officer Lappin duties included perimeter security.

Officer Lappin parked near the Wendy Restaurant located southwest of the Del Taco. While at that location, he saw the suspects' vehicle park next to the undercover's vehicle, which were located just west of the Del Taco. Shortly thereafter, he heard via his police radio that the "bust signal was given verbally" and waited to "watch the UC (undercover officer) walk away, giving the visional signal." At that time, the "bust team" approached the suspects. Officer Lappin immediately left the Wendy lot and drove to the south exit of the parking lot to prevent any escape by the suspects. At this time, he saw the suspects traveling east through the parking lot towards Del Taco. Then the suspects turned and continued west through the parking lot as he approached the south exit of the parking lot.

As Officer Lappin approached the south exit, he heard possibly three shots. Lappin briefly saw the suspects' vehicle travel westbound through the parking lot and did not see any of the collisions. As the suspects' vehicle traveled westbound in the parking lot, he also saw several fellow officers run northeast through the parking lot with their weapons drawn wearing vest with police / sheriff printed on them. Officer Lappin eventually exited his vehicle and saw that the suspects had stop. Lappin approached the suspects' vehicle and assisted fellow officers in the arrest of the suspects.

Diaz further explained that when the suspect realized that he had gone the wrong way, he (the suspect) backed up against the Pier One Imports Store. As the suspect began to pull forward, Diaz said he heard shots being fired.

I asked Diaz if he could see anyone who shot. He said that he could not. Diaz did say that he saw several officers around the suspect's vehicle.

I asked if he could hear the shots and how many. Diaz said that he thought he heard approximately six shots.

I asked who he saw around the car. Diaz told me he could only see Detectives Lattin and Reyes at that time. I asked if he could tell if Lattin and Reyes had their weapons out. He said that they did.

I asked if he could see what Reyes was carrying at the time. Diaz said that although he could not see what Reyes was carrying, he later saw what it was as he assisted in the arrest of the suspects.

Diaz further explained that he was to cover the east entrance of the parking lot. He said that as he began to drive eastbound in the main driveway of the complex, he saw that the suspect was driving the opposite direction (westbound). He backed his car up in that direction to block off the escape route.

Diaz said that after the vehicle stopped, he assisted in the arrest of the suspect seated in the back seat (Camez).

I asked if the suspect's vehicle was at rest when he assisted in the arrest. He said that it was. I asked if he saw the collision between the suspect's car and Det. Laubacher's truck. He said that he didn't in that he was backing up to get into position and did not see the collision, although Diaz did mention he heard it.

I asked Diaz about the arrest of the suspect in the back seat and where that subject was sitting. He told me the suspect was in the right rear seat, and the right front passenger seat was vacant.

I asked Diaz if he ordered the passenger out of the car. He explained to me that Reyes had already done so, and the suspect was halfway out, as he got to Reyes. After the suspect was out of the car, they both "proned" him out on the ground.

I asked Benavides if he saw Clancy hit the suspect vehicle. Benavides said Clancy struck the suspect vehicle in the right rear quarter panel.

I asked Benavides where Clancy was when he stopped his car. Benavides said Clancy was behind his car door with a detective yelling at the suspects.

Benavides described the driver's exit from the car as if he rolled out of the driver's door with his right foot still on the brake.

INTERVIEW DEPUTY KEVIN CLANCEY SN #2605 CENTRAL DIVISION CAMARILLO PATROL

On 10-22-01, 1850 hours, I interviewed Deputy Kevin Clancey at the scene concerning this investigation. The following is a summary of a tape-recorded interview I had with Deputy Clancey:

Deputy Clancey was assigned to assist the narcotic task force on an undercover operation as a security perimeter officer. Deputy Clancey was in uniform driving a marked black/white patrol unit. Deputy Clancey was initially parked near the park-n-ride lot located east of the parking lot at Los Posas Road and Hwy 101. Upon giving the signal via his police radio, Deputy Clancey's duties included driving to the east parking lot entrance / exit at Los Posas Road and securing the east end of the parking lot. Deputy Clancey entered the parking lot off of Los Posas Road. As he continued west into the parking lot, Deputy Clancey heard several shots. At the same time, he heard radio transmissions indicating the suspects were attempting to leave the parking lot.

As he passed the Del Taco, Deputy Clancey also saw Senior Deputy Reyes with his "weapon shouldered and saw people moving." Then Deputy Clancey stated he "saw the car (suspects) strike Senior Deputy Laubacher's vehicle. The collision occurred in the area between the Del Taco and the Pier 1 store. The suspect's vehicle was traveling west through the parking lot as the suspects hit Laubacher's front portion of his vehicle.

The suspect's vehicle continued traveling westbound through the parking lot. As Deputy Clancev had passed the Del Taco, he turned right (north) into the parking lot and attempted to follow the suspect's vehicle. Deputy Clancey was able to drive directly behind the vehicle. Deputy Clancey maneuvered his vehicle and struck the suspect's vehicle's left rear quarter-panel, causing the suspects to stop. At that time, additional officers arrived and assisted Deputy Clancey in the arrest of the suspects.

Deputy Clancey indicated he saw two suspects in the vehicle, one driving the vehicle and the other suspect located in the rear seat. Both suspects eventually complied with the officers' orders and were placed under arrest.

as a "GSW Fragment" (GSW – Gun Shot Wound). I clarified that the origin of the fragment was not in fact known and could be a piece of molding or metal from Rubio's vehicle or something else which was not known to us. Dr. also told me that she was going to clean the entry wound and attempt to retrieve the fragment, however she did not believe that she would be able to remove the fragment because it was deep in the shoulder. After cleaning the wound, Dr. told me she was not able to remove the metal from Rubio's arm. The fragment was left in place for evaluation and possible removal at a later date.

During this time, the second suspect (Peter Camez) involved in this incident was brought to VCMC by ambulance. I requested that he be placed in a treatment room far away from Rubio to avoid communication and overheard conversations. Detective Laughlin stood by with Camez while hospital staff evaluated him. Please refer to Laughlin's Narrative Report for details.

At about 1800 hours, I was advised by detectives at the scene to coordinate blood draws from both Rubio and Camez. Nurse conducted the draws. I witnessed both draws. Detective Laughlin took possession of the blood samples and later booked them at the Property Room Refrigerated lockers.

Detective Laughlin and I also photographed Rubio and Camez. Camez was photographed in the clothing he was wearing at the time of the incident. Due to Rubio's condition (i.e. being strapped to a backboard) I was unable to photograph him in his clothing. Instead I laid out his clothing and photographed them with Rubio in the background. I also photographed Rubio's entry wound on his left shoulder. Detective Laughlin took possession of the film and later booked it for processing.

At approximately 1834 hours, I was standing near Rubio's hospital bed. Unprompted, Rubio asked me, "Did any of those guys get hurt out there?" I responded, "I know two of them went to the hospital." To this Rubio responded, "Fuck!"

The second suspect, Camez, was cleared by hospital staff and was transported to the Headquarters Station by Deputy Mario Aguilar.

A short time later, Rubio was taken to the CAT scan room and had his head and neck evaluated. It was determined that he did not have any fractures in his spine or skull. Rubio was then cleared by hospital staff and was also transported to the Headquarters Station by Deputies Cerio and Anderson.

Once at the Headquarters Station, I arranged to have an evidence technician collect Rubio and Camez' clothing as evidence. Sgts. Aranda and Lorenzen arrived to conduct interviews of Rubio and Camez. Detective Laughlin and I prepared the booking paper work for Rubio and Camez. I also prepared a Declaration for Bail Increase in the amount of \$500,000 at the request of Sgt. Kelly for both Rubio and Camez.

After Aranda and Lorenzen completed their interviews, Rubio and Camez were escorted to the Main Jail where they were booked without incident.

After learning that both suspects had been transported to the Headquarters Station,

Aranda and I left the scene in Camarillo and drove to Ventura.

The first suspect to be interviewed was Alejandro "Alex" Rubio who was seated in an interview room.

The following is a synopsis of a tape recorded interview and is not verbatim.

Upon contact, I introduced Aranda and myself to Rubio. Sgt. Aranda then explained to Rubio what his charges were and the fact that we were there to interview him. Aranda then read Rubio his "Miranda Rights" from his department issued card. Rubio freely waived his rights by saying, "I have nothing to hide…might as well cooperate". The time was 2232 hours.

After receiving a waiver, Aranda started out by asking Rubio to tell us in his own words what had happened.

Rubio started by saying that he was just doing someone a favor. When I asked what the favor was, Rubio said that it was, "shooting somebody up to that place" (driving someone to Camarillo). Rubio added that he got "all paranoid" when he saw all the people coming out. He explained to us that he had just had a baby five days ago and he did not expect that a favor would turn out this bad.

I confirmed with Rubio that he was in fact the driver of the car. He confirmed that he was. Rubio also told us that his car was broken down and he had borrowed his mother's car.

I asked Rubio again about the favor that he was doing. He told us that he was giving someone a ride. I confirmed with Rubio that there were only two of them in the car. He agreed.

I then asked why they had come to Camarillo. Rubio explained that he was going to make some money for shooting (driving) his passenger up to Camarillo. When asked what the purpose was, he said that he didn't know until they got to Camarillo and he (Peter) began talking to him about it.

I asked Rubio when it was that Peter told him about the dope. He told us that he was the one that set Peter up with Steve (Capuano) after he had met Steve previously.

I asked Rubio when it was that he first "hooked up" with Steve. Rubio told us that he could not remember. He then said that it was about two or three weeks ago.

I asked Rubio about the first meeting with Steve and what kind of business they did. Rubio said he took Steve a "sample".

When asked how much the "sample" was, Rubio said, "it was an ounce and the price was \$900.00".

I asked if he remembered where he had met Steve. He told us that it was somewhere here in the area (actually Ventura). When asked if it was at a fast food restaurant, he thought that it may have been a "Carl's Jr." or a "Jack in the Box".

When asked what the talk was about, Rubio said that Steve had asked him if he had people that could do larger quantities or if he himself could do larger quantities.

Rubio said that they also talked about a pound. He added that after taking the "sample", Steve called and asked him how many pounds he could get. Rubio said he told Steve that he would have to find out.

Rubio told us that he talked to certain people and they said "no.... that there was only so much". When he told Steve this, he said that it was good.

When asked how many pounds he and Steve were talking about, Rubio held up four fingers. I confirmed with him that he meant four pounds, and he stated, "which was this right here". I asked if there were four pounds in the car. Rubio replied, "in the bag".

We then discussed Rubio's financial problems and the fact that he was having to pay for milk, baby books, formula, rent, bills, etc. while working only two days a week at his sister's flower shop.

Rubio also told me that he found his brother-in-law just after he had shot himself in the head. He explained to us that not only did this affect his sister, but it also got to him to a point where Rubio said he "lost it".

Rubio further explained to us that he did not make any money on the first delivery (one ounce) which was just a "sample". He added that this was supposed to be a one time thing and he was supposed to get \$750 for the "hook up" (on the four pounds) on today's deal.

I asked Rubio about his conversation with Steve today. Rubio said that Steve wanted him to "go down" and Rubio explained to him that he (Rubio) couldn't find "his boy" (supplier). Steve told Rubio that he had his pager and when he got together with his guy, he was to page Steve.

Rubio said that his guy became available and when he told him what was going on, the supplier told Rubio that they could do the deal. Rubio said that he told the supplier that he didn't want to do the deal and suggested he (the supplier) go alone. His supplier told him that he needed help.

I confirmed with Rubio that the supplier that he was referring to was his passenger, Peter. Rubio nodded his head in confirmation.

I asked Rubio about the trip up to Camarillo and if they had talked about a game plan. Rubio said that they didn't talk much on the way up.

Aranda asked Rubio why Peter was sitting in the back seat. He responded, "he (Peter) was going to count the money".

I asked Rubio about who brought the gun into the car. His response was, "where was the gun?". I told him it was in the back seat.

Rubio then said something to the effect of, "you should ask him" (referring to Peter).

Aranda then asked if he was aware that Peter had the gun. He said that he wasn't.

I asked Rubio if Peter had the "dope with him when they first "hooked up". He said that Peter told him that he would be right back as Rubio jumped into the shower. When Peter came back, he asked Peter to take him to the store so he could get something for his grandmother. He said that he also told Peter that he had to take his girl to the clinic to get her c-section checked out. With this, Peter suggested that he would park his car at Rubio's girlfriend's house and they could leave from there.

Rubio went on to say that he dropped his girlfriend off at the clinic, got gas, and they left. I asked Rubio if they (he and Peter) were together when he dropped his girlfriend off. He confirmed that they were.

I asked if Peter had the dope with him when he got in the car or if they had gone together to get the dope somewhere else. Rubio said that he already had the dope with him. I asked what Peter had the dope in. His response was, "a black bag".

I asked if they wrapped the dope or if it was already wrapped. Rubio said it was already wrapped.

I asked if he took it out to look at it or sample it. He said that he didn't see it (the dope) until he was with Steve and that's when he touched it.

I asked if he took it out to show Steve. He said that reached in and moved the bags around as he asked Steve if he wanted to open one of them.

Next, I asked Rubio what the agreed upon price was and he said, "ten on each". (\$10,000 per pound). I also asked what his portion would be, and he said it was \$750.

Aranda then confirmed with Rubio that each bag was \$10,000. Rubio said that's the price he understood from Peter.

I asked Rubio if he had talked to Peter about some scenarios if something were to happen. His comment was, "no sir".

Next I asked about talking to Steve and when he first thought that something was wrong. Rubio said that Steve was acting very nervous.

When asked what happened next, Rubio said he asked Steve if he was a cop.

I asked Rubio what Peter said while they were sitting in the car. He said that he blacked him (Peter) out.

I asked if Peter was yelling at him. Rubio told us that all he could tell us was, "I was thinking about my kid... my plan to get home no matter what....just one last time".

I asked Rubio about his asking Steve if he was a cop and the fact that Steve was nervous, if he had an idea that he was in fact a cop. He said that at the moment, he (Steve) answered, "I'm not a cop, not a DEA, not an FBI, and I'm not a terrorist". Rubio said to Steve, "cool, it's nice to know you're not going to kill us with Amtrax or some shit like that". Steve answered, "don't worry about it".

Rubio continued by saying that Steve brought up the subject about going to a hotel. Peter suggested that he jump in, and as they drive around, Peter could count the money. He added that Peter suggested that he go through the "drive thru", in that he was hungry. He told Peter that driving around would be too hectic and suggested that they get it over and done with. He said that his plan was for Peter to stay and count the money, while he went to get something to eat.

Rubio said to us, "you guys walked up, just as he was about to leave".

I asked him what the first thing he saw when he knew things were going wrong. His reply was, "guns".

When I asked about anything else, he said, I didn't care about nobody else, I cared about the guns". I then asked if he heard them yelling at him, he said, "not really, I blacked out...I wanted to see my kid".

I asked him what he thought was going to happen to him at that point. Rubio said he thought he was going to die.

I asked why he thought he was going to die. He answered, "I don't know, I just thought I was going to die".

When asked if he was afraid of going to jail, Rubio told me that right then he was, because he thought of his child being born just five days ago.

I asked him about when dealing with Steve, had it crossed his mind that he was going to jail, when everything started coming down.

He told us that he thought he was going to die, because at first he didn't think they were cops and were there to "rip somebody off" or shoot somebody. He explained that as he began to drive the wrong way into the "drive thru", he looked into the (rear view) mirror, and saw that they were the cops. He said that he almost ran into the sheriff and saw the yellow letters.

I asked Rubio why he didn't stop. He said that he did stop, but it was too late, and he hit the truck. He said that he blacked out and did not remember anything after that. He added that he didn't remember how the car got away from the truck.

I confirmed with Rubio that he was talking about the silver truck that was parked. He said that he remembered he backed around, hit the truck and then was stuck. He said he could not explain how his car went on to hit the black truck (Det. Laubacher's).

I asked Rubio about looking in his mirror and seeing that the subject behind him was a sheriff, why then didn't he put his hands up and stop.

Rubio said that he did, when he hit the truck, but somehow he didn't stop. He said that when he was going in reverse, he saw that it was a cop. To avoid hitting him or doing anything to him, he swerved, hit the parked truck, and this is when he blacked out "for like ten seconds".

I asked Rubio to explain to me how then, when he was backing up and hit the truck, did he put the car into gear to go forward. He said that he didn't understand why and that was when he blacked out.

I told Rubio that I didn't think he blacked out because he was able to put his car into drive. His response was that he already had his car in drive. He explained that when he was going in reverse, somehow he slammed on the brakes when he hit and he had his hand on the lever and he pulled it back. He said it was the only explanation that he had.

I asked him how he then hit the gas. Rubio said he blacked out and did not remember anything, until he hit the black truck (Laubacher). He said when he woke up, the car was "wobbling" and there was nothing in front of him. He then saw a police officer running up to him and yelling for him to put his hands out.

I asked Rubio about when things first started happening, what was Peter saying to him.

Rubio said that he blocked out Peter and did not pay attention to him.

I asked Rubio if he had ever done business with Peter before or had done business where it went well. He said that today was the first time and he was not a professional.

I asked Rubio how he knew Peter "was in the business". He told us that "the word" gets around on the street.

I asked if he went to Peter or did Peter come to him in reference to doing the first ounce.

Rubio said that after Steve wanted it (crystal meth) he told "his boy" about it. "His boy" told

Rubio to go ahead and run it out (take it to Steve) to see what these people are about.

I confirmed with Rubio that it was Peter he was talking about. He confirmed that it was by nodding his head.

I also confirmed with Rubio that after the first ounce was sold without a problem, that he contacted Peter in reference to the pounds that Steve wanted to buy. I asked Rubio what Peter said when he started talking pounds with him. He said that Peter told him that he wanted Rubio to do it by himself.

I asked him if Peter was going to trust him with four pounds. When he confirmed this, I asked him if he was related to Peter, in that this was very unusual for someone to "front" four pounds. Rubio said that Peter knew where his family lived and where he worked. He added that if anything happened, Peter would have his family killed.

Rubio went on to say that his intentions were not to burn anyone, but to get some toys for his kid and get some money for bills.

Rubio said that his sister cautioned him about doing what he was doing, in that he now had to think about his child.

I asked if his sister was aware of what he was doing. He said that she was, but did not agree with it.

I asked again about Peter getting into the car with him and if he was aware that Peter had a gun. Rubio told us that he had seen and held that particular gun before. He added "it's the only one that he gots".

I asked him if he knew what it was. Rubio said, "if it's the .25.... it's the only one he gots".

Aranda asked who the gun belonged to. After a short hesitation, Rubio answers, "he's always carrying.... I don't know if it's his... one of his friends".

I confirmed with Rubio he was telling us that he didn't bring the gun into the car. I next asked if his fingerprints were going to be on the weapon. Rubio answered, "I have touched that gun before". When asked when was the last time. Rubio answered, "Saturday... when they were talking about coming up there". He also said they were supposed to come up to Camarillo on Friday. I asked what happened, Rubio said that he didn't want to come.

I asked if Peter had the dope back then (Friday), and Rubio answered, "I didn't want to come... I was pushing him aside... both of them (Steve & Peter).

I again asked why Peter wouldn't come up to the area alone. He said Peter was scared because he didn't know him (Steve).

When asked if he told Peter about the first time he came up, he said that he did. When asked what Peter said about that, Rubio said that he figured that if they didn't bust him then (for the ounce) that he wouldn't get "popped" for today.

I asked if Peter had said where he got the dope from. Rubio said that it was from some people out there.

I confirmed with Rubio that Peter brought the dope with him when he got into Rubio's car and they did not go somewhere together to get the dope. Rubio agreed with this and mentioned that they put it in the trunk.

I asked Rubio about looking into the black bag before putting it into the trunk. He said that he didn't.

I asked if Peter said what was in the bag. Rubio said, "since we were going up there that he was taking that". I asked if Peter had said that he had all of it. He said that he did.

I asked if they talked about it being a "rip". He said that they didn't.

At this time, Det. Carlos Macias (Narcotics) entered the interview room. I introduced Macias to Rubio and explained that Det. Macias was also one of the case agents in the narcotic aspects of this investigation.

Before we started with questions from Det. Macias, we took a short break and stepped out of the interview room for several minutes.

When we came back into the interview room, Det. Macias confronted Rubio about some of his inconsistencies. Macias then told Rubio that he watched him retrieve the "crystal" in the black bag from the trunk of his black T-Bird that was broken down at his residence.

There was additional dialogue with Rubio as to this being his first time and the fact that he was given four pounds. Rubio insisted that he was fust the "middleman" with Steve and Peter was the one who had the connection for the dope. He said that Peter didn't want to go see someone in the middle of nowhere, so that's why he (Rubio) went along.

Shortly after this, we ended our interview with Rubio. He was then escorted downstairs and was booked.

The above is only a synopsis of a tape recorded interview and is not verbatim. The tape was given to Sgt. L. Kelley the case agent.

Note: At the beginning of the interview, Rubio speaks in a very low voice and is hard to hear on tape. There is also a buzzing noise in the background of the tape, which makes it difficult to discern some of the conversation.

Alex told us that the purpose of their trip to Ventura was to receive some money from a "white friend" (NFD). Sgt. Lorenzen asked Peter where he resides. Peter said that he lives in Wilmington and Alex is his neighbor.

Sgt. Lorenzen asked Peter how they met on this day. Peter told us that he was driving to his residence when Alex met him. Peter said that they were exchanging comments about each other's car stereo speakers when Alex asked him to accompany him to Ventura. Peter said that he agreed to join Alex on his trip to Ventura.

Sgt. Lorenzen asked Peter how long he has known Alex. Peter responded that he has known Alex for approximately 5 months. Peter told us that Alex is not a childhood friend. Peter said that Alex is merely a neighbor in the complex where they reside.

Sgt. Lorenzen asked Peter why they were traveling to Ventura. Peter again told us that Alex was going to receive some money from a white friend. Peter told us that he did not ask Alex what the money was for or the amount he was going to receive.

Peter said that he told Alex that he would accompany him only if he was able to bring his (Peter's) compact disks. Peter told us that Alex prefers to listen to Spanish music, but he (Peter) does not prefer this type of music. Peter told us that his CD's are in a black case, which was left in Alex' vehicle.

Peter told us that he started to think that something was "fishy" due to meeting Alex' friend in a public place (Del Taco). Peter said that he heard the white guy say something about a motel and this made him even more suspicious. Peter said that Alex told him to sit in the back seat of the car, so his white friend could sit in the front seat. This occurred when they arrived to the

Del Taco parking lot area. Sgt Lorenzen asked Peter why he was told to sit in the back seat. Peter responded by telling us that Alex and his friend were going to count money. Peter told us that he did not know how much money Alex was receiving from his friend.

Sgt. Lorenzen asked Peter what occurred after they contacted Alex' white friend. Peter said that "a bunch of dudes came out with uh, big ole automatic weapons" and Alex drove off. Peter said he did not realize what Alex was doing, when all of a sudden, he heard a gunshot and then another gunshot. Peter told us that he put his head down and then felt Alex' vehicle become involved in two separate collisions. Peter said, "I heard you guys shooting at us and that was it. I didn't want to be part of that. At all. As soon as he (Alex) stopped, I put my hands out the window and that was it."

Sgt. Lorenzen asked Peter when they met Steve (Alex' white friend) how did he know something was wrong. Peter told us that he felt something was "fishy" when Steve told Alex that they could "do this at a motel." Peter told us that he was sure we have the situation recorded.

Sgt. Lorenzen asked Peter what he meant by, "you guys." Peter said that he saw the "cars" and heard the people yelling, "Police Officers or Sheriffs."

Sgt. Lorenzen asked Peter if he said anything to Alex. Peter said that he asked Alex "what are you doing?" Peter said that Alex went one way (through the Del Taco parking lot) and realized it was the wrong way and yelled, "shit." Peter said that he heard one of the officers shoot out the tire (NFD). Peter said that once he heard the officers shooting, he feels "lucky that I'm here right now." Peter thought that once the shooting began, the other officers would get "trigger-happy" and continue shooting.

Peter said that he ducked behind a child car seat (located inside the vehicle) and heard Alex' vehicle stop due to a collision. Peter said that he placed his hands out a window and that was it.

Peter told us that he is not aware of Alex' business or why the events unfolded as they did. Peter said he did not have anything to do with what occurred. Peter told us that he was there only as a companion for Alex while he received some money.

Sgt. Lorenzen asked Peter if they went to any other location when they arrived in the City of Camarillo. Peter said that they did not stop at any other location in Camarillo. Peter then recanted and said that they might have stopped at a gas station (NFD). Peter said that he did not pay attention, but Alex did exit their vehicle.

Sgt. Lorenzen asked Peter if he saw Alex go to and open the trunk of their vehicle. Peter said that he was not paying attention and could not tell us for sure if Alex went to the trunk of their car.

Sqt. Lorenzen asked Peter if he and Alex had any discussions while they were enroute to Camarillo. Peter said that they talked about situations at home and as far as he knew, Alex was going to receive some money from Steve. Peter said that he was listening to his music most of the time while they were traveling to Camarillo.

Sgt. Lorenzen asked Peter if he was the front passenger during their trip. Peter acknowledged that he was the front passenger.
